Defensive Pistol discipline is quite simply the use of practical equipment including full charge service ammunition to solve simulated “real world” self-defense scenarios.

Participants in Defensive Pistol events are required to use practical handguns and holsters that are truly suitable for self-defense use.

The use of duty gear is strongly recommended for those armed professionals who participate in our scheduled matches.

No “competition only” equipment is permitted in Defensive Pistol matches, since the main goal is to test the skill and ability of an individual, not his equipment or gamesmanship.

Schedule Matches will be held on every 3rd Saturday of the month, in the Tactical Pistol range, 0900 - 14:30.

### Bullseye Pistol

Bullseye pistol, also known as conventional pistol, is a shooting sport in which participants shoot handguns at paper targets at fixed distances and time limits. At Desert Marksman Rifle and Pistol Club we host a bullseye match on the fourth Sunday of each month from March through October. The matches in March and October are weather dependent. The entry fee is \$10.00 per person.

All courses of fire are fired from a standing position, using a one handed grip. This is a significantly more difficult shooting position than the two handed grips used in action shooting, at “bullseye” targets

*Continued from page 1.* significantly smaller and farther, although time constraints are relatively more generous. Three courses of fire are followed: Slow Fire, in which ten rounds are fired in ten minutes, Timed Fire, consisting of two five-round strings with twenty seconds for each string, and Rapid Fire, which has a ten second limit for each of the two five-round strings. All shooting is done one-handed, standing, with no support. In Desert Marksmen's matches, the competitor is required to shoot 90 rounds using "any gun" (usually a .22 semi-auto) and 90 rounds using "any center fire" (usually a .45 semi-auto or .38 revolver), although any center fire pistol regardless of caliber is permitted. Each shot scores a maximum of 10 points. Hence, a one-gun competition is often referred to as a "900" whereas a two-gun competition is an "1800". Although many competitors use iron sights, optical sights such as red dot scopes are also permitted. Any sight, such as a laser sight, that projects an image on the target is not permitted.

Outdoor competitions are fired at 50 yards (slow fire) and 25 yards (Timed & Rapid Fire) using the same target.

Shooting Bullseye Pistol competition requires great attention to the fundamentals of shooting such as sight alignment, sight picture, trigger control, and breathing. Successfully practicing these principles during a Bullseye Pistol match will certainly transfer to all of the other shooting disciplines and make you a better all around shooter. We welcome new shooters and coaching is available. Where else can you get a total of 180 rounds of practice in a single match? Come out and enjoy yourself!
