Important Range Information

Once again I'm going to write common sense information in this section.

These are club or Forest Service rules and must be obeyed. The speed limit on the road into our range is **15 MPH** maximum.

The speed limit in our range area is **10 MPH**.

Not only is this common courtesy to other members it is a huge safety concern.

DO NOT shoot from under the Black Powder Range cover unless a Black Powder Match is in session. If you want to shoot shotguns while the Pistol Range is in use you may, please see illustration on the back page.

DO NOT shoot in the camping areas. Shooting is only allowed on the ranges.

YOU MUST display you member sticker on your vehicle.

YOU MUST have your member card with you if you are on the range. If asked by any member you must show that card to another member.

YOU MUST have a Forest Service Permit and permission from the Club to have a fire in the fire pit.

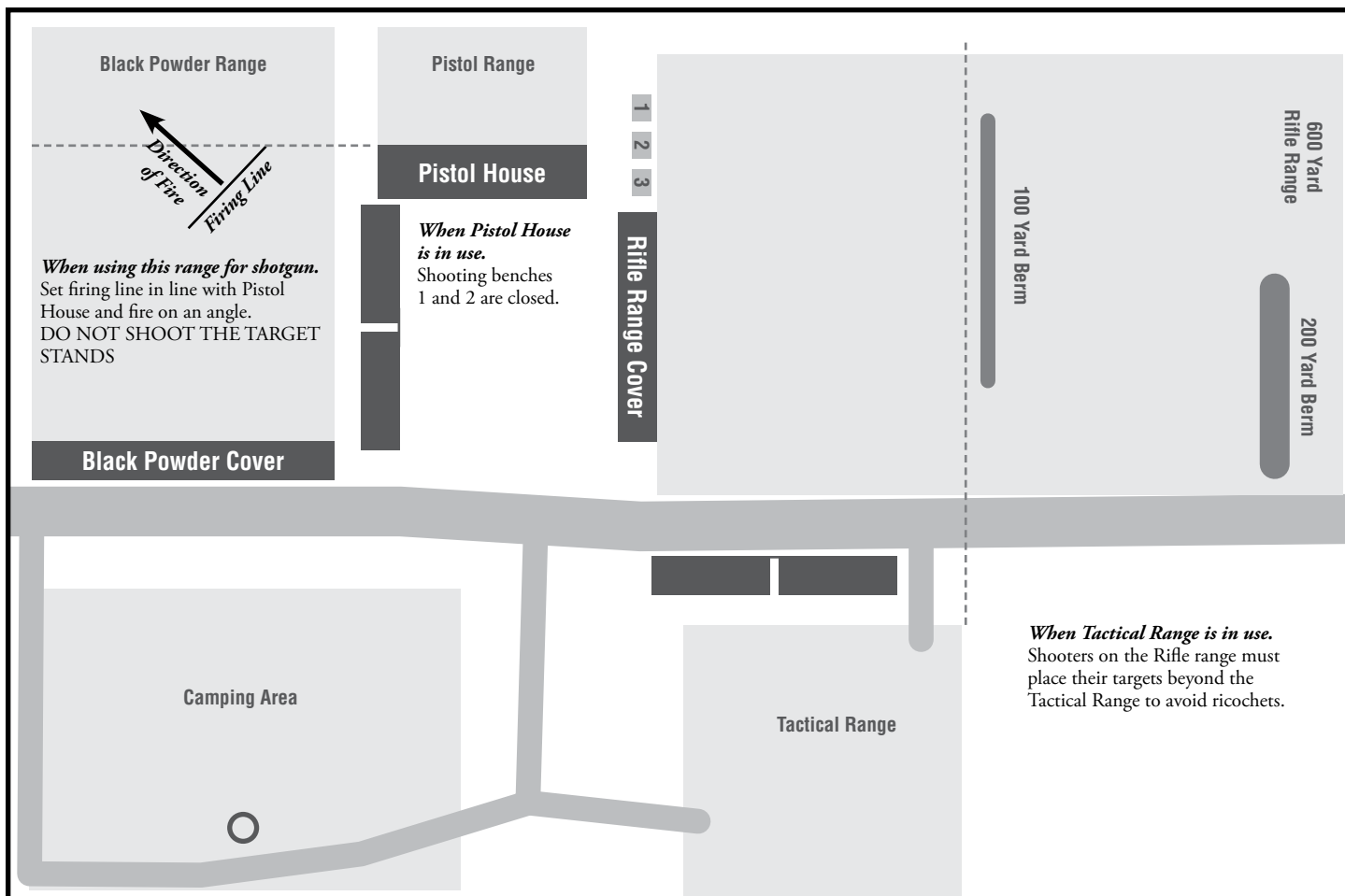
